Fee Payment Modes

Full Annual Fee Payment Concession

A concession equivalent to two months' tuition fee shall be granted to parents who deposit the full annual fee in advance on or before 10th April of the academic year.

Biannual Fee Payment Option & Concession

Considering the local economic cycle in the region, the school offers a Biannual Fee Payment Option for parents who prefer to schedule payments in alignment with harvest periods.

Parents opting for this mode shall be eligible for a concession equivalent to one month's tuition fee for the academic year. This concession will be proportionately adjusted and distributed across both biannual installments.

Under this option, the total payable fee (including Annual Charges and Tuition Fee) shall be divided into two installments:

- Installment 1 (May Cycle – April to September): Payable on or before 31st May
- Installment 2 (January Cycle – October to March): Payable on or before 31st January

Monthly Payment Option with Flexible Annual Charges

The school offers a Monthly Payment Option with flexibility in the payment of Annual Charges, allowing parents to choose a mode that best suits their financial planning.

Under this option, parents may choose either of the following:

Fee Concessions & Benefits

Sibling Concession

The school provides a Sibling Concession to support families with more than one child enrolled concurrently in the school.

This concession is applicable only on the Tuition Fee component.

The concession shall be applied progressively based on the number of siblings studying in the school at the same time, as follows:

- 1st Child: No concession
- 2nd Child: ₹250 per month concession on tuition fee
- 3rd Child and Onwards: ₹300 per month concession on tuition fee

The concession is applicable to children of the same parent(s), including biological, adopted, and stepchildren, provided they are enrolled and studying in the school simultaneously.

This concession shall be valid only for children who are legally recognised as siblings under the same parentage. It shall not be applicable to cousins or any other relatives, even if they are residing in the same household.

The concession shall remain valid only for the duration during which multiple eligible children are actively enrolled in the school.

Employee Fee Concession

The school provides tuition fee concessions to its employees as part of staff welfare benefits.

Employee fee concession is provided to legal offspring and dependent grandchildren of the employee, and shall not be extended to cousins, siblings of parents, or any other relatives, even if residing in the same household.

The concession amount, where applicable, shall be deducted from the employee's salary on a monthly basis.

For **Teaching / Academic Staff**, the concession is structured as follows:

- The first child is eligible for a 50% concession on tuition fee and a 25% concession on annual charges.

- For the second child and onwards, employees are eligible for a 30% concession on tuition fee and a 20% concession on annual charges.

For **Support Staff**, which includes attendants, housekeeping staff, drivers, helpers, and similar roles, all eligible children are entitled to a 70% concession on tuition fee and a 25% concession on annual charges.

The concession is applicable only while the employee is in active service with the school.

The school reserves the right to review, modify, or withdraw the concession based on employment status, performance, or institutional requirements.

Girl Child Concession

The school offers a Girl Child Concession as part of its educational welfare initiatives to support and encourage the education of girl students.

This concession is applicable only where the student is the only girl children in the family, subject to verification.

This concession shall not be applicable to students whose parent(s) are serving in government employment, as they are considered to have access to additional institutional benefits.

The concession shall be applicable on both the Annual Charges and Monthly Tuition Fee components as follows:

- First Eligible Girl Child: 25% concession on Annual Charges and a ₹400 reduction in Monthly Tuition Fee.
- Second Eligible Girl Child and onwards: 20% concession on Annual Charges and a ₹350 reduction in Monthly Tuition Fee.

The concession is applicable only while the student continues to meet the eligibility condition of being the only girl child enrolled in the school. Eligibility shall be subject to annual verification.

Sri Rajkumar Scholarship – Compassionate Educational Assistance Program

The school offers financial assistance under the Sri Rajkumar Scholarship to support students who are not under the direct care of both parents and are being raised within their extended family or close kin.

This scholarship is designed to ensure continuity of education for such students and is granted based on verified circumstances and assessed need.

Under this scholarship, eligible students shall receive the following concessions on academic fees:

- Annual Charges: 25% concession
- Monthly Tuition Fee: ₹500 reduction per month

The scholarship is subject to annual review, and continuation will depend on academic performance, conduct, and reassessment of circumstances.

Important Conditions

Parents must select their preferred payment option at the beginning of the academic session, and the chosen mode shall remain applicable for the entire academic year.

No concession shall be applicable on transportation charges.

The school offers various concession schemes to support different student and staff categories. However, only one concession category may be availed per student per academic year. Accordingly, no concession stacking shall be permitted.

The school reserves the right to approve, review, modify, or withdraw concessions, revise concession structures, and interpret eligibility or application in cases requiring clarification, in accordance with institutional policy and financial sustainability, with prior intimation to parents where applicable.

Payment Process

1. The school accepts fee payment through the following modes:

Online Transfer (NEFT/RTGS/UPI)

Cheque Payment in favour of the School (student details must be mentioned on the reverse side)

Cash Payment at the School (receipt will be issued immediately)

2. Parents are requested to ensure timely payment through any of the above modes and retain proof of payment for records.

Late Fee – Penalty

1. Fees not paid by the **10th of the month** will attract a late fee penalty.
2. A late fee of **₹10 per day** will be charged for delays **up to one month** from the due date.
3. A late fee of **₹20 per day** will be charged for delays **beyond one month and up to two months** from the due date
